Contestants Qualifications

Each Contestant in the International Puppy Contest (IPC)

1. Must be at least 21 years of age.
2. Must identify as a puppy
3. Must have a demonstrated interest in being a puppy & puppy play as determined by the judging panel.
4. Must agree to appear on stage wearing their puppy and/or fetish gear.
5. Must own all gear worn on stage during the contest.
6. Must agree to return to International Puppy Contest next year, if they win, to step aside from their title and may be asked to be a judge in the contest.
7. Must agree to permit on stage photographs to be taken for the use on **International Puppy** and **Tampa Bay Leather n Fetish Pride**.
8. Read and Agree to the terms of the statement of "What is Expected of the Winner".

Meet & Greet is Friday November 9, 2012 starting at 7pm located at the Flamingo 4601 34th Street S., St. Petersburg, FL 33711 (727) 321-5000. All contestants and judges must be at the Meet & Greet no later than 6:45pm. Contestant numbers will be picked at the opening of Tampa Bay Leather n Fetish Pride.

- **Contestants & Promoters Meeting:** 10:30am - 11:30am Saturday November 10, 2012 at the Flamingo.
- **Interviews:** 3:00pm **SHARP!!!** Saturday November 10, 2012. 10 to 15 minute interviews at the Flamingo. Contestants must be in the dressing room by 2:45pm.
- **Contest Starts:** 8:00pm to 11:00pm Saturday November 10, 2012 at the Flamingo all contestants must be in the dressing room no later than 7:30pm.

Victory Brunch is Sunday November 11, 2012 11:00am to 2:00pm all Contestants and Winner must attend.



Judging Method

International Puppy Contestants shall be scored by a panel of judges using scoring system in the categories and points outlined:

1. **Interview:** Up to 60 points per judge. Each individual contestant will meet with the judging panel offstage prior to the contest to answer the judges questions about the contestant's interest in being a puppy, knowledge on Human puppies and the interaction with his community and willingness and ability to represent the title. Hoods are not to be worn during the Interview and must be done standing. For extra points, mitts, knee pads, collars, leashes and puppy tails can be worn. Arm/wrist bands, hankies etc may also be worn. Clothing (if any) should be puppy casual but should not be the same outfit they wear during any other category, however, since puppies don't usually wear clothes, puppy interviews with the judges are clothing optional (decided by the individual pup). Everywhere else they have to wear street legal attire as it's a public event (by law, jocks/thongs in Pinellas County have to have a minimum of 1 inch width in back or be covered by a hankie). This is also where a vet inspection (if any) can be done.
2. **Introduction:** Up to 20 Points per judge for **Speech** & up to 20 points for **Image**. Each individual contestant will appear onstage to introduce them self to the audience and briefly describe their background or interest in the puppy community, while wearing the attire that best represents their **puppy** image but for extra points they should bark sometime during their speech. It is not encouraged to expound on a political "platform". The onstage introduction shall be no longer than **two (2) minutes**. And will wear their full puppy gear to impress (harnesses, chaps, body suits etc). For extra points they should be on all fours when entering the stage, but must stand during their speech, wearing mitts, knee pads, collar, leash, hood and tail. Arm bands, hankies etc may also be worn
3. **Jock Category:** Up to 40 points per judge. Each individual contestant shall appear onstage in body revealing attire which emphasizes their physical feature. For extra points they should be on all fours, wear mitts, knee pads, collar, leash, hood and tail. Arm/wrist bands may also be worn.

The time restrictions shall be strictly enforced for each of these categories. The time restrictions and allocation of points may be modified with prior notice to the contestants and sponsors.

Fraternization with Judges: All contestants shall be prohibited from having private meetings or engaging in any sexual activities or puppy scene play with judges prior to the announcement of the results. Any behavior that might create even the appearance of bias will be brought to the attention of the head judge, who will decide if the disqualification of the judge and/or contestant is warranted. To avoid accidental violation of this policy, all contestants and judges should display their identification badges at all contest events.



What is Expected of the Winner

- The foremost duty of the Winner is to promote the goals of the International Puppy event and organization and its local sponsors in a positive light throughout the year.
- One of the foremost expectations that we have of our Winner is that during their title year, they will conduct them self as a positive role model. Flagrant violation of this expectation may result in forfeiture of their title.
- The Winner may not compete in any other "Puppy" contests during their title year.
- If the Winner can not fulfill their duties as International Puppy, the remaining unused travel fund/prizes, medallion, and patch must be returned to the IPC Directors IMMEDIATLY. Then the First Runner Up becomes the new Winner and takes on the title and duties that are required.
- The Winner will be invited to judge next years IPC if they have fulfilled all their obligations during their title year. Judging the contest is not a guarantee but will be encouraged.
- The Winner is required to do 1 fundraising event for IPC
- \$1,000.00 Cash Prize
- Medallions
- Patches
- And other prizes
- The Winner are encouraged to attend as many other major leather events and contests as they may see fit.
